Detailed Guidelines / Instructions for the Participants

All team members are advised to read the complete guidelines thoroughly for the active participation in the event.

Registration

- 1) Each team would comprise of up to maximum of 4 members including the team leader. All team members should be from the same Institute.
- 2) Teams may have one faculty mentor from their parent institute.
- 3) Team members CANNOT be associated with more than one team. Any such attempt will lead to disqualification of the teams.
- 4) Student teams will not be allowed to add or delete any new participants in the team after the registration.
- 5) Team to select most appropriate problem statement(s) out of the given themes and prepare structured idea document(s) for presentation and submission.
- 6) Teams are also encouraged to think out-of-the-box and provide creative solutions to themes.

- 8) Eligibility criteria and details shall be checked by the registration teams before allotment of a Team No.
- 9) Team ID will be mailed to the Team Leader of the project by 30thOctober, 2023. All the further correspondence will be held using this Team ID.
- 10) All team members should be available on 4thNovember, 2023 for the evaluation purpose at 11:00 am sharp at Sharda University Campus.

Evaluation

- 11) If there is a tie between two or more teams, the final decision of the prize distribution will be taken by panel of judges.
- 12) The evaluation will be conducted by panel of Judges and the judgment will be solely based on the evaluation rubrics.
- 13) Evaluation criteria will include novelty of idea, complexity, clarity and details in prescribed format, feasibility, practicability, sustainability, scale of impact, user experience, potential for future work progression etc.
- 14) It is strongly recommended that the teams must focus on submission of quality solutions with well thought approach to stated problem(s).
- 15) The Idea document PPT for a team must be in 5 slides, format and converted into a PDF
 - a. The first slide will include –Team number, Name of team Leader, name of team members and Institution Name/Affiliation.
 - b. The second and third slide will include – Problem Statement, Description of Your Idea, Solution, Prototype, and Description of the Technology.
 - c. The fourth slide will include – Description of Your Use Cases/Applicability.
 - d. Any other information related to proposed solution.
- 16) Along with the presentation the team needs to demonstrate their project idea or prototype
- 17) It is mandatory for all the participants to be formally dressed during their evaluations.
- 18) Only the registered teams will be allowed to present the mentioned problem statements to the panel of judges.
- 19) The mentors may attend the evaluation, but the presentation shall be done by the participants only.
- 20) All Participants including mentor should have their valid Institutional ID card/ Bonafide letter displayed during the evaluation.
- 21) Certificate will be provided to all participants of the team if they presented their idea to the panel.
- 22) Faculty mentors shall be felicitated with certificate of appreciation.
- 23) The time of evaluation shall be from **10:00 a.m. to 01:00 p.m.** on the day of evaluation. Reporting time for the teams at the venue is **09:45 a.m.**
- 24) The decision of judges will be final and binding on all teams. In case of any issues with the evaluation, teams can appeal to the jury.

- 25) Teams who fail to appear at the appointed time may be allotted zero by the evaluation team. No representation of any kind will be accepted for nonappearance at the given time of evaluation.
